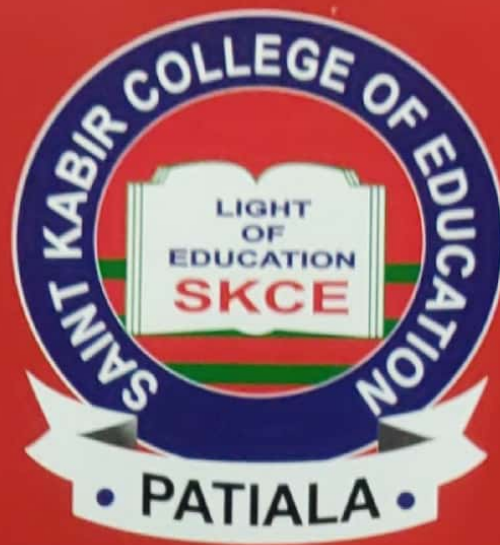

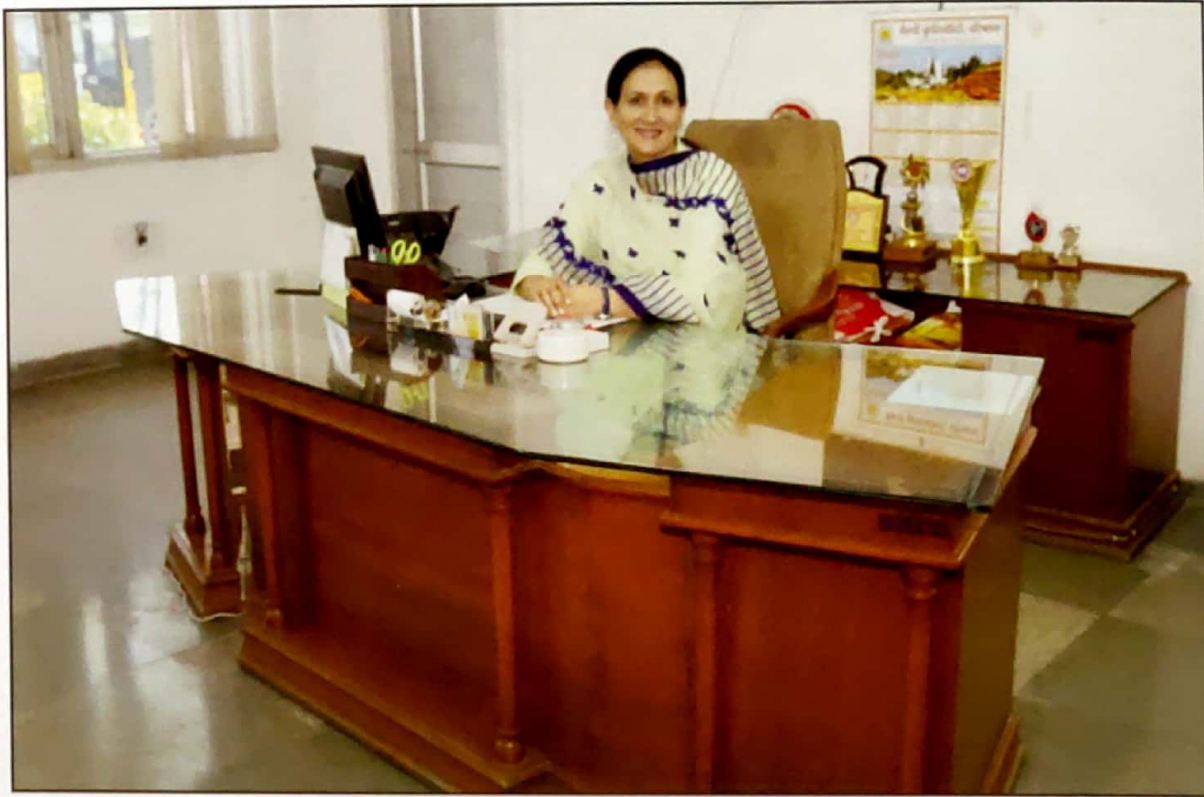

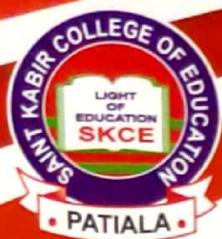

The details of the seats on the basis of different categories is as per rules guided by the Punjabi University/SCERT.

ADMISSION

A candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination and his/her result is still awaited may apply provisionally at his/her own risk, subject to the condition that he/she will submit the result or proof of meeting the eligibility requirements at the time of interview. his/her candidature will be cancelled in case of non-submission of result and fulfilling eligibility norms by the required date for admission purpose.

The candidates are required to present the original certificates issued by the appropriate authority along with other required document at the time of interview. The candidates selected for admission will be required to deposit the dues and three passport size photographs immediately. The admission of the candidates who fail to deposit their dues by the notified time will automatically stand cancelled and seats so vacated will be offered to the candidates next on merit.

Important

1. Admitted Candidate who fails to pay his dues up to the prescribed date to be notified at the time of interview) will lose right to get admission.
2. Fee once paid shall not be refunded in any way whatsoever.
3. The college management retains the right to change the fee from time to time at any time during the course of study at the college.
4. Candidates from the universities other than the Punjabi University may be admitted provisionally provided they are otherwise eligible and fulfill the requirements of the regulations concerning the examination. This will, however be subject to the confirmation by the Punjabi University. Such candidates are required to submit in the college office the following documents. etc. within fifteen days of their admission in the college:
 - a. Original certificates (self attested) of the examination passed by the candidates.
 - b. Migration certificate in case of the candidates who have graduated from a university other than Punjabi University.

Reservation

Reservation of the seats under various categories to be filled in the college and domicile requirement are as prescribed by the Punjab Govt.

COLLEGE DUES

The fee for full session will be charged in two installments. In the first installment, the selected candidates shall be required to deposit the full fee for the first semester and annual charges at the time of admission. The fee for the second semester will be charged before the commencement of second semester.

The students of second year (Part II) of each course will also be required to seek admission in the beginning of the third semester. They will fill up the admission form available in the office of the College and deposit the fee for the third semester. Similarly they will deposit the fee for the fourth semester before the start of the same semester.

Fine from the students who fail to deposit the fee as per schedule will be charged at the rate to be decided by the management.

GENERAL RULES

The students are expected to abide by the following rules:

1. Regularity and punctuality in attendance in classes and house examinations is absolutely essential for all the students on rolls in the Class.
2. No student will be allowed to accept any employment during the course of training.
3. Teacher trainees should not wear gaudy/mod dresses and must avoid the use of cosmetics. They must put on the college uniform, when required.
4. Students in their free period are expected to make use of the reading room and library.
5. Student is liable to be expelled on any of the grounds i.e. misbehaviour, breach of discipline and disobeying college rules.
6. Refund of security is ordinarily permissible after the declaration of University results. Securities not withdrawn within one month from the removal of name of a student from the college rolls will be forfeited.
7. The College authorities observe strict rules of conduct of the students. The students are also required to attend the morning assembly and stay at the College campus for the full College time. Any breach of these restrictions shall be treated as an act of misconduct.
8. Guardians and parents will please note that visitors are not allowed to see the students during the college hours.
9. The visiting hours for general public and parents to meet the Principal are from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
10. The students who will indulge in strike or hooliganism in the college will be dealt with severe action including rustication from the college.
11. Ragging of the students is strictly banned in the college. If any student is found ragging the other students, strict appropriate action will be taken against him/her.
12. Smoking and drinking is strictly banned in college campus.
13. Writing and sticking bills on the walls and desks of the college is strictly prohibited.



ATTENDANCE

College will start with first period at 9.00 a.m. (both in summer and winter). Attendance will be taken in each period. To become eligible for university examination, a student is required to attend 75% of the lectures delivered in each paper. After the end of each month, lecture record of each student in each paper will be displayed on the notice board. Each student is supposed to see this chart and for any error, he/she should contact the concerned teacher immediately and get the error rectified.

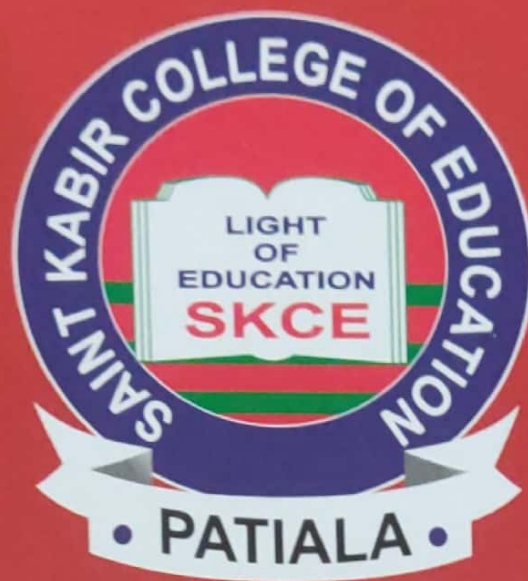
